- 1. Why are you running for school board? If you are an incumbent, what do you wish to pursue through continued service? If you are a new candidate, what do you hope to accomplish as a trustee?
- 2. If elected, what current issues will be your top priorities over the next 3 years?
- 3. What guiding principles will serve you in your decision-making process as a trustee?
- 4. What will be your approach to closing the social and academic gaps caused/exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic?
- 5. What do you believe is standing in the way of all children receiving a high-quality public education?
- 6. Describe your view of the roles of the school board and of the superintendent. What is the ideal relationship between them?
- 7. When you review the district budget, which contains hundreds of pages, what will be your process to determine if you will approve it?
- 8. How do you identify underserved student populations and what is your strategy to ensure all students are being served?
- 9. Please share a concrete idea for supporting each of the following groups: 1) district teachers and employees, 2) district students, and 3) district families.
- 10. What role should the community play in the district and how do you expect them to hold you and the rest of the board of trustees accountable?
